

AIR QUALITY ADVISORY: Public Health Alert for Wildfire Smoke (more info)



Gypsum Improved air quality as showers become more likely.



Sweetwater Just downwind of the fire, UNHEALTHY for SENSITIVE GROUPS (USG) at times.



McCoy Westerly winds to carry smoke towards McCoy on occasion.



Eagle Improved air quality compared to previous days.



Dotsero Smoke from the Derby Fire will occasionally overspread Dotsero.



FIRE

The Derby fire is currently estimated at 5248 acres and is 0% contained. Fire activity for the Derby fire is expected to remain active.

SMOKE

Smoke production is expected to be somewhat less noticeable today compared to previous days, as the probability of wetting rains continues to increase. Many locations around the Smoke Outlook area will see GOOD to MODERATE air quality for much of the day. Fewer hours of UNHEALTHY for SENSITIVE GROUPS (USG) are predicted for Sweetwater. As monsoonal moisture continues to stream into Colorado, air quality should improve as we head into next week.
