
SMOKE OUTLOOK NW Colorado – Derby Fire

Gypsum Minimal smoke expected from the Derby Fire but low levels of drift smoke from Oregon and Idaho is expected.



Sweetwater Minimal smoke expected from the Derby Fire but low levels of drift smoke from Oregon and Idaho is expected.



McCoy Minimal smoke expected from the Derby Fire but low levels of drift smoke from Oregon and Idaho is expected.



Eagle Minimal smoke expected from the Derby Fire but low levels of drift smoke from Oregon and Idaho is expected.



Dotsero Minimal smoke expected from the Derby Fire but low levels of drift smoke from Oregon and Idaho is expected.



FIRE

The Derby fire is currently estimated at 5736 acres and is 6% contained. Fire activity for the Derby fire is expected to remain low.

SMOKE

With clearer skies and lower humidity more smokes should become visible. Only low levels of smoke is expected from the smoldering of large fuels in the dense conifer forest. Smoke impacts should be limited to the immediate vicinity of the fire with no impact expected in the communities. Yesterday, low levels of drift smoke from fires in Oregon and Idaho caused periods of MODERATE air quality at some locations. That is expected again today. The Outlook area can expect GOÓD air quality most of the day with periods of MODERATE possible as the drift smoke from out of state adds to what is normally in the area.

SPECIAL STATEMENT

Isolated showers and thunderstorms develop on terrain today. Impacts will be limited to some gusty winds, small hail, and brief downpours. Flash flooding is not expected today.
