

**Sweetwater** Minimal smoke expected from the Derby Fire but there will be low levels of drift smoke from Oregon and Idaho.



**McCoy** Minimal smoke expected from the Derby Fire but there will be low levels of drift smoke from Oregon and Idaho.



# **Eagle** Minimal smoke expected from the Derby Fire.



**Dotsero** Minimal smoke expected from the Derby Fire but low levels of drift smoke from Oregon and Idaho is expected.



### **FIRE**

The Derby fire is currently estimated at 5738 acres and is 6% contained. Fire activity for the Derby fire is expected to remain low.

### **SMOKE**

Low levels of smoke expected from the limited fire behavior that has been observed. With more sun and lower humidity the amount of smoke from the Derby Fire should increase today. Smoke impacts are expected to be restricted to the immediate vicinity of the fire with no influence expected in the communities. The previous two days saw low levels of drift smoke in the Outlook area from fires in Oregon and Idaho . This out of state smoke caused periods of MODERATE air quality at some locations. This pattern is expected again today as all of western Colorado will see a mixture of GOOD and MODERATE air quality.

### SPECIAL STATEMENT

Isolated showers and thunderstorms develop on terrain today, favoring the San Juans. Impacts will be limited to some gusty winds, small hail, and brief downpours.
