LOCAL ADVISORY: Hazardous Weather Outlook (more info)



Gypsum Recent, and forecasted, rains will improve air quality,



Sweetwater Less smoke due to recent, and forecasted, rains.



McCoy Decreasing smoke due to recent, and forecasted, rains.



Eagle GOOD air quality expected all day.



Dotsero Less smoke due to recent, and forecasted, rains.



FIRE

The Derby fire is currently estimated at 5723 acres and is 4% contained. Fire activity for the Derby fire is expected to decrease.

SMOKE

Decreasing smoke with decreased fire behavior. However, smoldering in the dense conifer forest can be expected to continue. Smoke should be limited to the immediate fire vicinity with limited impact to communities. The Outlook area can expect GOOD air quality during the day. The only area that might experience periods of MODERATE is the Sweetwater Creek drainage.

SPECIAL STATEMENT

Flash flooding and debris flows are possible in sensitive areas, such as slot canyons and recent burn scars.

HEALTH STATEMENT

Smoke can be harmful to your health. Check with your doctor if there are any health concerns and monitor your local air quality conditions using the Fire and Smoke Map.
